


Stewart was born in New York City in 1953. She studied history at the University of California, Berkeley, and she worked as a journalist before

Stewart is a passionate advocate for human rights. She has worked with several organizations to help refugees and victims of war. She is also a member of the International Committee for the Red Cross.


Stewart lives in Berlin with her husband and two children.

Aimee Jaguar in Ravensbrück




