
Annette Funicello: A Tribute from Fans and Friends



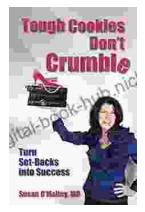
