
Bootstrap Geologist: My Life in Science





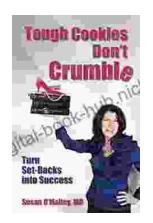
