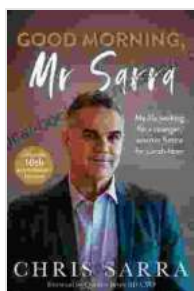


Good Morning, Mr. Sarra: A Tale of Resilience and Redemption

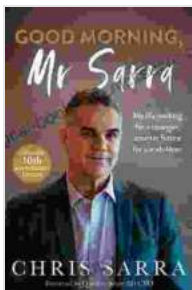
