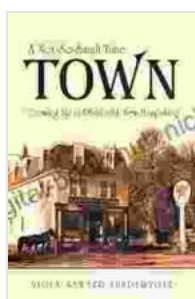


Growing Up in Plainfield: A Nostalgic Journey to the Heart of Small-Town New England

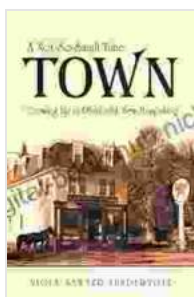
