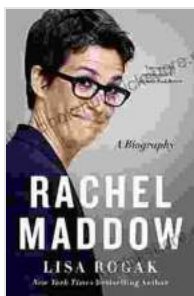


Rachel Maddow: A Journey from Radio Reporter to Political Commentator

Radio Career

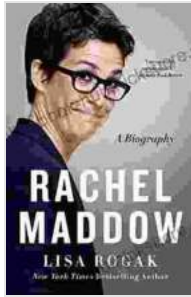

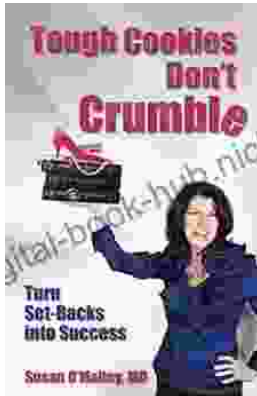
