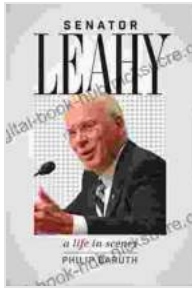

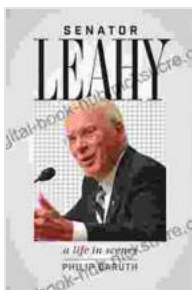


Legacy

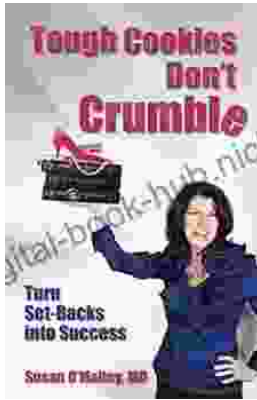
