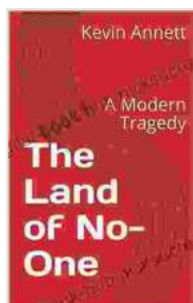

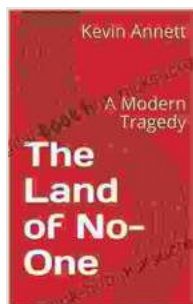
The Land of No More
